HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 648, L.D. 929, Bill, "An Act To Create Freedom of Citizen Information Regarding Ballot Questions and Political Action Committees"

Amend the amendment in section 1 in subsection 2 in the first line (page 2, line 1 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "statements" the following: 'placement of information'

Further amend the amendment in section 1 in subsection 2 by inserting at the end the following new blocked paragraph to read:

'The summary of the proposed direct initiative must be printed on the petition immediately following the statements required by this subsection.'

SUMMARY

This amendment clarifies that the placement of the summary of the proposed initiative is to be immediately following the required statements at the top of the petition.
