Resolved: That, no later than January 15, 2006, the Director of the Bureau of Parks and Lands within the Department of Conservation shall submit a report to the Joint Standing Committee on Agriculture, Conservation and Forestry including the acreages and locations of lots owned and managed by the bureau in towns and plantations that have incorporated since January 1, 1973 and a listing of towns and plantations that have incorporated since January 1, 1973 where all of the previously designated public lots have been traded or transferred.

The Director of the Bureau of Parks and Lands shall include in the report model provisions for the sale of wood to ensure, wherever practicable, that the wood from public lands is marketed to enhance the local economies with due consideration for fairness and equity on competitive markets.'

This amendment is the minority report of the Joint Standing Committee on Agriculture, Conservation and Forestry. It replaces the resolve. It directs the Director of the Bureau of Parks and Lands within the Department of Conservation to report to the Joint Standing Committee on Agriculture, Conservation and Forestry with information on the disposition of the public lots in towns and plantations that have incorporated since January 1, 1973. The resolve also requires the director to review contract provisions for the sale of wood and develop model provisions that give preference to local markets.
