HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 655, L.D. 936, Bill, "An Act To Amend the Maine Tort Claims Act"

Amend the amendment in section 1 in subsection 3 in the last line (page 1, line 37 in amendment) by striking out the following: "negligent" and inserting in its place the following: 'reckless'

Further amend the amendment in section 2 in paragraph C in the 2nd line from the end (page 2, line 4 in amendment) by striking out the following: "negligent" and inserting in its place the following: 'reckless'

SUMMARY

This amendment amends Committee Amendment "A" by providing that there is no immunity for reckless operation of a motor vehicle that results in a collision as opposed to the negligent operation of a motor vehicle as Committee Amendment "A" now provides.
