COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A to S.P. 318, L.D. 943

SUMMARY

This amendment replaces the bill. The amendment enables petitions to be filed with the Director of the Bureau of Labor 4 Standards within the Department of Labor to institute a supplemental wage and benefit survey to determine a prevailing 6 wage for a trade or occupation that has more than 10 workers, if that trade or occupation was not part of a previous wage and hour 8 survey.
