22	Amend the bill in section 2 in that part designated
24	" <u>\$1311-A.</u> " by striking out all of subsection 2 (page 1, lines 33 to 50 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:
26	'2. Quarantine for dogs without proof of rabies
28	vaccination. An animal control officer shall ascertain the status of a dog's vaccination against rabies upon receiving a report that the dog has bitten a person or a domesticated animal.
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32	If an owner or keeper does not provide a valid certificate of rabies vaccination for a dog within 24 hours of a request for
34	such certification by an animal control officer, the animal control officer shall make a determination as to where the dog must be kept during the guarantine period established in rules
36	adopted pursuant to section 1313. The animal control officer may
38	place the dog in a licensed boarding kennel, animal shelter or veterinary clinic for observation during the guarantine period. The owner of the dog is responsible for all expenses incurred
40	while the animal is under guarantine.'

SUMMARY

10 This amendment is the minority report of the Joint Standing Committee on Agriculture, Conservation and Forestry. It allows 12 an animal control officer to determine the place of quarantine for a dog that has bitten a person or domesticated animal. It 14 increases the fine for failure to abide by quarantine provisions and other rules adopted to control rabies.
