20 COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 687, L.D. 977, Bill, "An
22 Act To Create a Civil Violation for Operating a Snowmobile Left
of Center"

24 Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting
26 clause and before the summary and inserting in its place the
following:

28 'Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §13106-A, sub-§26 is enacted to read:

30 26. Operating snowmobile left of center of snowmobile
32 trail. A person may not operate a snowmobile to the left of the
34 center on a snowmobile trail that is funded in whole or part by
the Snowmobile Trail Fund when approaching or navigating a curve,
corner, grade or hill.

36 A. A person who violates this subsection commits a civil
38 violation for which a fine of not less than \$100 and not
more than \$500 may be adjudged.

40 B. A person who violates this subsection after having been
42 adjudicated as having committed 3 or more civil violations
under this Part within the previous 5-year period commits a
Class E crime.'
