Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

2
4 Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §13106-A, sub-§5, ¶I is enacted to read:

6 I. A person may not operate a snowmobile on a private way
8 or on a public way pursuant to this subsection or subsection
10 4 to the left of the center of the way. Notwithstanding the
12 provisions of paragraph H, a person who violates this
14 paragraph commits a civil violation for which a fine of \$100
16 must be adjudged.

SUMMARY

14 This bill makes operating a snowmobile to the left of center
16 of a private or public way a civil violation for which a fine of
 \$100 must be adjudged.
