Based on its review of the issues, the task force shall develop a proposal as to whether there is a need to retain the insured value factor in tuition computation; and be it further

8 Sec. 2. Submission of proposal. Resolved: That, no later than January 9, 2006, the chair of the task force convened pursuant to 10 section 1 shall submit its proposal, along with any necessary implementing legislation, to the Joint Standing Committee on 12 Education and Cultural Affairs. The Joint Standing Committee on Education and Cultural Affairs is authorized to introduce a bill 14 related to the insured value factor to the Second Regular Session 12 of the 122nd Legislature.
