### Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 32 MRSA §1083. as amended by PL 1993, c. 600, Pt. A, §65, is further amended to read:

#### 6 §1083. Application for examination; subjects; reexamination

8 The board may at its discretion recognize the results of an examination given by the National Board of Dental Examiners or an 10 accredited clinical testing agency approved by the board in lieu of or in addition to the examination or examinations that it may 12 The board shall recognize a passing grade on an require. examination given by any regional testing agency. The board may require as part of the examination a clinical demonstration of 14 the candidate's skill in dentistry. An applicant who fails to pass the first examination to the satisfaction of the board is 16 entitled to one reexamination. Applicants for licensure shall pay a fee set by the board for the examination. 18

#### **SUMMARY**

This bill provides that the Board of Dental Examiners shall accept as part of its requirements for licensure a passing grade from any regional testing agency as an alternative to an examination by a northeast regional testing agency.
