SENATE AMENDMENT "E" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 338, L.D. 998, Bill, "An Act To Authorize Department of Transportation Bond Issues To Match Available Federal Funds for Improvements to Highways and Bridges; Airports; Public Transit; State-owned Ferry Vessels and Ferry and Port Facilities; Port and Harbor Structures; Development of Rail Corridors and Improvements to Railroad Structures; and Statewide Trail and Pedestrian Improvements"

Amend the amendment in Part D in section 5 in the 3rd line (page 11, line 7 in amendment) by striking out the following: 'the Department of Education,'

Further amend the amendment in Part D in section 6 by striking out all of that part relating to "DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION" (page 12, lines 13 to 17 in amendment)

Further amend the amendment in Part D in section 6 in that part relating to "UNIVERSITY OF MAINE" in the 2nd blocked paragraph in the first line (page 12, line 24 in amendment) by striking out the following: "\$1,000,000" and inserting in its place the following: '\$2,000,000'

Further amend the amendment in Part D in section 10 by striking out all of the question (page 13, lines 15 to 29 in amendment) and inserting in its place the following:

"Do you favor a \$20,000,000 bond issue to stimulate economic growth and job creation through investments in the Maine economy in anticipation of approximately \$44,000,000 in federal and private funds for medical research and development; marine research and development; equity investments in small Maine companies with potential for high growth; the New Century Community Program for capital improvements to cultural resources; the renovation of Camden Hall on the University of Maine Bangor campus for a graduate
