SENATE AMENDMENT "**P**" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 338, L.D. 998, Bill, "An Act To Authorize Department of Transportation Bond Issues To Match Available Federal Funds for Improvements to Highways and Bridges; Airports; Public Transit; State-owned Ferry Vessels and Ferry and Port Facilities; Port and Harbor Structures; Development of Rail Corridors and Improvements to Railroad Structures; and Statewide Trail and Pedestrian Improvements"

Amend the amendment in Part F in section 1 in the 4th line (page 16, line 19 in amendment) by striking out the following: "\$8,900,000" and inserting in its place the following: '\$9,900,000'

Further amend the amendment in Part F in section 5 in the 4th line (page 17, line 1 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "Protection," the following: 'the Maine State Housing Authority,'

Further amend the amendment in Part F in section 6 by inserting after that part relating to "**DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION**" the following:

'MAINE STATE HOUSING AUTHORITY
Provides funds for lead paint abatement. \$1,000,000'

Further amend the amendment in Part F in section 10 by striking out all of the question (page 18, lines 18 to 25 in amendment) and inserting in its place the following:

'"Do you favor a \$9,900,000 bond issue for purposes related to agriculture and the environment in anticipation of approximately \$34,000,000 in federal funds to be used for sustainable water sources and irrigation system development,
