COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 696, L.D. 1012, Bill, "An Act To Improve Security at State Courthouses"

Amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "~~§58.~~" by striking out all of subsection 2 (page 1, lines 11 to 17 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

'2. Source of fund. The fund consists of all money appropriated or allocated for inclusion in the fund, from whatever source, and any other resources available to the fund.'

Further amend the bill by striking out all of section 2 and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 2. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and allocations are made.

JUDICIAL DEPARTMENT

Courts - Supreme, Superior, District and Administrative 0063

Initiative: Provides a base allocation in the event that additional funding is collected to support the activities of the Courthouse Security Fund.

This bill establishes a Courthouse Security Fund to be administered by the Judicial Department. The Fund shall consist of any money appropriated or allocated for this purpose. An allocation of Other Special Revenue funds is included in fiscal year 2005-06 in the amount of \$500 in the event that additional funds are collected to support the activities of the Fund.
