Fiscal Detail and Notes

The amendment changes the effective date of the health insurance subsidy program from July 1, 2007 to January 1, 2007 and funds the cost of the subsidy during this six-month period with an increase in the assessment from 1.5% to 2%, and with a one-time transfer of \$1,359,245 from the Maine Budget Stabilization Fund. The increase in the assessment to 2% also decreases the estimated General Fund cost of the subsidy in 2007-08 and 2008-09.
