	1. Shopping centers. In any building or facility
18	constructed specifically as a shopping center after September 19,
	1985, there must be installed a minimum of 2 toilets for the use
20	of the public. There must be at least one separate toilet for
	each sex and the toilets provided must be clearly marked,
22	maintained in a sanitary condition and in good repair. Lavatory
	facilities must be located within or immediately adjacent to all
24	toilet rooms or vestibules. No charge may be imposed for their
	use.

	2. Retail stores. Except for a retail store in a shopping
28	center under subsection 1, if a retail store of at least 500
	square feet in area has a rest room facility, the retail store
30	shall make that rest room facility available for public use.
