3 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §13155, sub-§5**, as amended by PL 2003, c. 695,
5 Pt. B, §13 and affected by Pt. C, §1, is repealed and the
6 following enacted in its place:

7 **5. Fee.** The annual ATV registration fee is:

8
9 A. For a resident, \$30. The registration for an ATV owned
10 by a resident is valid for one year, commencing on July 1st
11 of each year. A person who obtains a resident ATV
12 registration after March 31st may pay \$37.50 and receive a
13 registration covering the remainder of the registration
14 period plus one additional year; and

15 B. For a nonresident:

16
17 (1) Forty dollars for a registration valid for 3
18 consecutive days. A person may purchase more than one
19 3-day registration in any season;

20
21 (2) Fifty-five dollars for a registration valid for 10
22 consecutive days. A person may purchase more than one
23 10-day registration in any season; and

24
25 (3) Sixty-five dollars for a seasonal registration.

26
27 The registration for an ATV owned by a nonresident must
28 specify the dates for which the registration is valid.

29
30 Five dollars from each registration fee collected pursuant to
31 this subsection must be transferred to the ATV Recreational
32 Management Fund established in section 1893, subsection 2.

37 **38** This bill creates a short-term registration system for
38 all-terrain vehicles for nonresidents similar to the short-term
39 registration system established for snowmobiles.
