SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 360, L.D. 1043, Bill, "An Act To Provide Funds for the Preservation of Digital Records"

Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

**'An Act To Provide Funds for Online Reference Materials'**

Further amend the bill by striking out all of section 1 and inserting in its place the following:

**Sec. 1. Appropriations and allocations.** The following appropriations and allocations are made.

**MAINE STATE LIBRARY**

**Statewide Library Information System**

Initiative: Provides funds to negotiate and purchase licenses for the publication of copyrighted materials and periodicals to create a statewide database for use by state, school, public and academic libraries in the State. The licensing agreement must include, subject to the availability of funds, a full-text reference collection, full-text newspapers, full-text consumer health information and full-text periodical databases for general research and business research.



#### Fiscal Detail and Notes

This amendment reduces the General Fund cost of the bill by \$72,556 in fiscal year 2005-06 and \$89,410 in fiscal year 2006-07.

As amended, this bill eliminates the funding for a Management Analyst II position within the Department of the Secretary of State, Maine State Archives and, instead, provides an annual General Fund appropriation of \$25,000 per year beginning in fiscal year 2006-07 to the Maine State Library for the purchase of licensing agreements for copyrighted online reference materials.
