SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 361, L.D. 1044, Bill, "An Act To Care for Families"

Amend the amendment in subsection 7 in the last 4 lines (page 2, lines 42 to 45 in amendment) by striking out the following: "For purposes of imposing a penalty for a violation of subsection 2, each day that a request for leave under this section is denied constitutes a separate violation."
