<u>\$1120-A. Indemnification agreements against public policy</u>	
	1. Agreements void and unenforceable. It is against pub
pol	icy and is void and unenforceable if, notwithstanding
	er provision of this chapter, a provision, clause, covenant
agr	eement contained in, collateral to or affecting a construct
con	tract or a contract involving the harvesting of timber,
	tract involving maintenance of property engaged in
	vesting of timber or a contract attendant to timber
	dworking operations of any nature, purports to indemnify
<u>pro</u>	misee against liability for damages for:
	A. Death or bodily injury to persons;
	B. Injury to property;
	C. Design defects; or
	D. Other loss, damage or expense arising under paragraph
	<u>B or C from the negligence or willful misconduct of</u>
	promisee or the promisee's agents, servants or independ
	contractors, who are directly responsible to the promisee.
	2. Exceptions. Nothing in this section affects
val	idity of an insurance contract for workers' compensation
<u>any</u>	other insurance contract or agreement issued by a licen
ins	urer.
	SUMMARY
	This bill prohibits certain indemnification agreements
whi	ch a contracting party indemnifies itself from its
neq	ligence or willful misconduct.
