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	This resolve is a concept draft pursuant to Joint Rule 208.
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	This resolve proposes to establish a study commission to
8	examine water district fees assessed for fire suppression. The
	membership of the study commission would include interested
10	parties throughout the State, including municipal representatives
	from large and small municipalities, public safety officials,
12	firefighters, water districts, water companies and the Public
	Utilities Commission. The study commission would be charged with
14	the duty of examining whether water district fees assessed for
	fire suppression are equitable and the ramifications of altering
16	those fees and whether the amounts charged to municipalities
	should be limited in some way. The commission would be given
18	authority to report its findings to the Second Regular Session of
	the 122nd Legislature.

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
