COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "**A**" to S.P. 380, L.D. 1063, Bill, "An Act To Improve the Guardian ad Litem System"

Amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "**S1-112.**" by striking out all of subsection (h).

Further amend the bill by striking out all of sections 3 and 5.

Further amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment deletes from the bill the language that provides that guardians ad litem do not have to pay certain court filing fees and fees for driving records and criminal record checks.
