COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 732, L.D. 1079, Bill, "An Act To Require Publicly Funded Entities To Report Undocumented Illegal Aliens"

Amend the bill by striking out all of section 1 and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §1522 is enacted to read:

§1522. Notification to federal agency

If a member of a public or private organization that receives state funds has contact in the course of the member's official duties for the public or private organization with a person that member knows to be an undocumented illegal alien, that member or that organization shall notify the United States Department of Homeland Security, United States Citizenship and Immigration Services or a successor organization unless the member's knowledge is based on information that is privileged.

For purposes of this section, "member" means an agent, employee, owner, director or person otherwise associated with an organization.'

SUMMARY

This amendment is the minority report of the Joint Standing Committee on Judiciary. It revises the bill to require a member

2 of an organization that receives state funds to notify the United
States Department of Homeland Security, United States Citizenship
and Immigration Services if the member has contact with a person
4 the member knows to be an undocumented illegal alien. The
contact with the known undocumented illegal alien must arise in
6 the course of the official duties of the member of that
organization. The notification is not required if the member's
8 knowledge is based on information that is privileged.
