This amendment is the minority report of the Joint Standing Committee on Judiciary. It revises the bill to require a member

of an organization that receives state funds to notify the United States Department of Homeland Security, United States Citizenship and Immigration Services if the member has contact with a person the member knows to be an undocumented illegal alien. The contact with the known undocumented illegal alien must arise in the course of the official duties of the member of that organization. The notification is not required if the member's knowledge is based on information that is privileged.
