be it enacted by the reopie of the State of Maine as follows:
Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §1521 is enacted to read:
§1521. Notification to federal agency
If a member of a public or private organization that
receives state funds has contact with a person that member
believes to be an undocumented illegal alien, that member or that
organization shall notify the United States Department of
Homeland Security, United States Citizenship and Immigration
Services, or a successor organization.
For purposes of this section, "member" means an agent,
mployee, owner, director or person associated with an
rganization.
SUMMARY
This bill requires a member of an organization that receives
state funds to notify the United States Department of Homeland
Security, United States Citizenship and Immigration Services if
the member has contact with a person the member believes to be an
undocumented illegal alien.
