COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 738, L.D. 1085, Bill, "An Act To Require Alcohol Retailers To Post Signs Regarding the Laws Governing Alcohol"

Amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "\$15." in the first paragraph in the first line (page 1, line 7 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "43"

Further amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "\$15." in the first paragraph in the last line (page 1, line 10 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "2081." the following: 'A person who violates this section commits a civil violation for which a fine of not less than \$50 nor more than \$200 may be adjudged for any one offense.'

Further amend the bill by inserting after section 2 the following:

'Sec. 3. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and allocations are made.
