2           **Sec. 1. Study establishment of North Woods Park. Resolved:** That  
3 the Department of Economic and Community Development, Office of  
4 Tourism shall study the feasibility of establishing the North  
5 Woods Park, a state park adjacent to Baxter State Park. The  
6 study must include an assessment of the impact on natural  
7 resources in the area and on the economy in the region of the  
8 proposed park. The office shall determine what land is available  
9 in the area for the park and the cost of purchasing or otherwise  
10 acquiring such land, including through donations and grants. The  
11 office shall submit a report to the Second Regular Session of the  
12 122nd Legislature by January 15, 2006, including any necessary  
13 implementing legislation.
