COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 749, L.D. 1096, Bill, "An Act To Make Technical and Minor Changes in the Capitol Planning Commission"

Amend the bill by inserting after section 1 the following:

'Sec. 2. 5 MRSA §298, sub-§4, as enacted by PL 1977, c. 513, §1, is amended to read:

4. Members-at-large. Four citizens of the State, who shall may not be residents of Augusta, to be appointed by the Governor for terms of 2 5 years; except that the first appointed member shall must be appointed for a term of one year.'

Further amend the bill by striking out all of section 2 and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 2. Resident and at-large members. The resident and at-large members of the Capitol Planning Commission holding office on the effective date of this Act hold office for the terms for which they were elected, and as each term expires the new member is elected for 5 years. If a vacancy arises, it must be filled for the remainder of the unexpired term.'

Further amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.
