HOUSE AMENDMENT "**A**" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 753, L.D. 1100, Bill, "An Act To Set Emission Limits for Certain Architectural Coatings"

Amend the amendment in the first paragraph after the title in the last line (page 1, line 24 in amendment) by inserting at the end the following: 'and inserting in their place the following:

'B. Varnishes may not contain volatile organic compounds in excess of 450 grams per liter. Effective January 1, 2011, varnishes may not contain volatile organic compounds in excess of 350 grams per liter.'

SUMMARY

This amendment includes a volatile organic compounds limit for varnishes of 450 grams per liter and further provides that effective January 1, 2011, the limit for varnishes will be lowered to 350 grams per liter.
