COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 753, L.D. 1100, Bill, "An Act To Set Emission Limits for Certain Architectural Coatings"

Amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "~~S585-J.~~" in subsection 1 by striking out all of paragraphs B, C, D and E (page 1, lines 25 to 36 in L.D.)

SUMMARY

This amendment is the minority report. It deletes from the bill limits on the amount of volatile organic compounds that may be contained in varnishes, sanding sealers, exterior wood primers and floor coatings.
