COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 759, L.D. 1106, Bill, "An Act To Amend Certain Animal Health Laws"

Amend the bill by striking out all of section 2 (page 1, lines 10 to 34 in L.D.)

Further amend the bill in section 3 in that part designated "\$1902." in the indented paragraph by striking out all of the last sentence (page 2, lines 8 to 10 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following: 'The commissioner may accept money from any public or private source for deposit into the fund. The fund may be used to pay costs associated with the administration and activities undertaken by the State of Maine Animal Response Team in accordance with section 1901.'

Further amend the bill by inserting after section 3 the following:

'Sec. 4. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and allocations are made.

Initiative: Provides initial allocations for the State of Maine Animal Response Team Fund.

12 This amendment removes the section in the bill that proposed
making confidential certain records relating to animal testing
and disease. It clarifies that the Commissioner of Agriculture,
14 Food and Rural Resources can accept private and public funds for
deposit into the State of Maine Animal Response Team Fund and
16 clarifies for what purpose the fund may be used. It also
corrects a cross-reference and adds an appropriations and
18 allocations section.

Beginning in fiscal year 2005-06, the establishment of the State of Maine Animal Response Team Fund within the Department of Agriculture, Food and Rural Resources will require an initial annual Other Special Revenue Funds allocation of \$500.
