COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 775, L.D. 1122, "Resolve, To Establish the Wabanaki Trail"

Amend the bill in section 1 in the first paragraph in the 8th line (page 1, line 8 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "and create" the following: 'web-based'

Further amend the bill in section 3 by striking out all of the last sentence (page 1, lines 22 to 24 in L.D.)

**SUMMARY**

This amendment clarifies that the task force shall create web-based maps. The amendment also strikes language from the bill authorizing the Joint Standing Committee on Transportation to report out a bill to the Second Regular Session of the 122nd Legislature.
