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SUMMARY

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This amendment replaces the resolve. The amendment directs each state agency to establish a process by which municipalities that are involved in the joint provision of services with other units of government may fulfill statutory filing requirements by filing jointly with those units. It requires state agencies to report on the progress and the status of changes to the Executive Department, State Planning Office by November 30, 2006. Planning Office shall report recommendations to the joint standing committee of Legislature having jurisdiction over state and local government The amendment gives authority to the committee to report out legislation to the First Regular Session of the 123rd Legislature.
