2 **Sec. 1. Call-sharing agreement. Resolved:** That the Department
of Public Safety, Bureau of State Police and the county sheriff's
4 departments shall enter into a call-sharing agreement. The State
Police and the county sheriff's departments shall coordinate
6 their forces to have each unit cover 1/2 of a county at a time.
The units shall work out a schedule so that the State Police
8 covers 1/2 of a county for a certain amount of time and the
county sheriff's department for that county covers the other half
and once that period of time is over, the units switch halves.

SUMMARY

14 This resolve directs the Department of Public Safety, Bureau
16 of State Police and the county sheriff's departments to enter
into a call-sharing agreement.
