Presented by Representative McKENNEY of Cumberland. Cosponsored by Representative: CARR of Lincoln, Senator: DAVIS of Piscataquis. Sec. 1. Call-sharing agreement. Resolved: That the Department of Public Safety, Bureau of State Police and the county sheriff's departments shall enter into a call-sharing agreement. The State Police and the county sheriff's departments shall coordinate their forces to have each unit cover 1/2 of a county at a time. The units shall work out a schedule so that the State Police covers 1/2 of a county for a certain amount of time and the county sheriff's department for that county covers the other half and once that period of time is over, the units switch halves.
