COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 787, L.D. 1144, "Resolve, Directing the Maine State Retirement System To Develop a Proposal To Provide Relief for Retired State Employees"

Amend the resolve by striking out the title and substituting the following:

'Resolve, Directing the State Employee Health Commission To Develop a Proposal To Provide Relief for Retired State Employees'

Further amend the resolve by striking out everything after the title and before the summary and inserting in its place the following:

Sec. 1. State to pay percentage of increase. Resolved: That, with respect to retired state employees who are eligible for Medicare and who must enroll in that program and pay the Part B premium, the State Employee Health Commission shall develop a proposal under which the State contributes a percentage of the increase in that premium; and be it further

Sec. 2. Report. Resolved: That the State Employee Health Commission shall submit its proposal pursuant to section 1, along with any necessary implementing legislation, to the Joint Standing Committee on Insurance and Financial Services no later than November 2, 2005. Following its receipt and review of the report, the committee may report out a bill to the Second Regular Session of the 122nd Legislature.'
