2 **Sec. 1. State to pay percentage of increase. Resolved:** That, with
3 respect to retired state employees who are eligible for Medicare
4 and who must enroll in that program and pay the Part B premium,
5 the Maine State Retirement System shall develop a proposal under
6 which the State contributes a percentage of the increase in that
7 premium; and be it further

8 **Sec. 2. Report. Resolved:** That the Maine State Retirement
9 System shall submit its proposal pursuant to section 1, along
10 with any necessary implementing legislation, to the Joint
11 Standing Committee on Labor no later than November 2, 2005.
12 Following its receipt and review of the report, the committee may
13 report out a bill to the Second Regular Session of the 122nd
14 Legislature.
