An Act To Establish a Muzzle-loading Shotgun Season on Deer

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows: 2 Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §11405 is enacted to read: 4 <u>§11405. Muzzle-loading shotgun season on deer</u> 6 1. Muzzle-loading shotgun season. There is a special 8 muzzle-loading shotgun season on deer in expanded archery areas as established by the commissioner immediately following an 10 expanded archery season as established by the commissioner for the purpose of hunting deer only with a muzzle-loading shotgun as 12 defined in section 10001, subsection 42-B. The muzzle-loading shotgun season on deer is separate from the muzzle-loading-only 14 deer season under section 11404. The commissioner may terminate the muzzle-loading shotgun season on deer at any time in an area 16 if, in the commissioner's opinion, an immediate emergency action is necessary due to adverse weather conditions or severe hunting 18 pressure. The length of the muzzle-loading shotgun season on deer is as follows: 20 A. The commissioner shall establish by rule the length of 22 the special muzzle-loading shotgun season on deer in expanded archery areas after an expanded archery hunting 24 season. The season may extend for no more than 6 hunting days and must end by the Saturday before Christmas Day. 26 2. Applicability of laws. The following provisions apply 28 during the muzzle-loading shotgun season on deer: 30 A. The commissioner's authority to regulate the harvest of antlerless deer under section 11152 is applicable during the muzzle-loading shotgun season on deer; 32 B. Deer tags for the muzzle-loading shotgun season on deer 34 must be issued for use in the same manner and in addition to the muzzle-loading-only deer_season; 36 C. Except as provided in this section, the provisions of 38 this Part relating to deer apply to the taking of deer with 40 muzzle-loading shotguns; and D. Only one deer of either sex may be taken during the 42 muzzle-loading shotgun season on deer, in addition to any deer taken during the regular open hunting season on deer. 44 46 **SUMMARY 48** This bill establishes a muzzle-loading shotgun season on 50 deer in the expanded archery areas of the State and after the

archery season, as established by the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife. It is in addition to the regular hunting season, and a deer tag must be purchased in addition to the other fees.
