3. Report. A regional water council shall make an annual 2 report of its activities to the member utilities. The report must be filed with the Public Utilities Commission and the 4 drinking water program of the Department of Health and Human Services. 6 §6808. Coordinator 8 1. Public Utilities Commission. The commission serves as 10 the coordinator between regional water councils and the State. The commission may obtain and distribute state and federal funds 12 supporting regional council tasks and may provide assistance to regional water councils as appropriate. This subsection does not

14 require the commission to determine the appropriate disbursement of state and federal funds among members of a regional water 16 council.

18 2. Rulemaking. The commission may adopt rules to establish procedures and audit requirements related to the requirements of this section. Rules adopted pursuant to this subsection are routine technical rules as defined in Title 5, chapter 375, 22 subchapter 2-A.

SUMMARY

This bill allows water utilities to form regional water 28 councils.
