rod industry to provide advice and technical assistance to the State Police regarding custom vehicles and recommendations on potential inspection standards and procedures. The Chief of the State Police shall report back to the Joint Standing Committee on Transportation no later than February 1, 2006. The report must include the status of the committee and any findings and recommendations for the committee's continuance, discontinuance or modification.

Sec. 6. Effective date. Those sections of this Act that enact the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 29-A, section 101, subsection 19-A; amend Title 29-A, section 457, subsections 1 and 6; and enact Title 29-A, section 458-B take effect July 1, 2006.'

SUMMARY

18 This amendment removes language from the bill that creates a definition for "blue dot taillight." The amendment also amends 20 the definition of "custom vehicle" and establishes registration and safety inspection requirements for custom vehicles. The amendment further requires the Chief of the State Police to 22 convene a committee of interested parties to provide advice and 24 technical assistance regarding custom vehicles and recommendations on potential inspection standards and procedures. It also requires the committee to report back to the Joint 26 Standing Committee on Transportation no later than February 1, 28 2006 with any findings and recommendations.
