Amend the bill by inserting after section 10 the following:

Sec. 11. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and allocations are made.

PUBLIC SAFETY, DEPARTMENT OF

Licensing and Enforcement - Public Safety 0712

Initiative: Provides for the reinstatement of 2 State Police Detective positions and one Clerk Typist III position eliminated in Public Law 2003, chapter 451 necessary to provide program oversight and investigations.

Fiscal Detail and Notes

The increase of certain licensing fees will increase Other Special Revenue Funds revenues collected by the Department of Public Safety by \$307,813 and \$410,419 in fiscal years 2005-06 and 2006-07, respectively.

The bill includes additional Other Special Revenue Funds allocations for the Department of Public Safety in the amounts of \$227,836 and \$275,819 in fiscal years 2005-06 and 2006-07, respectively, for the costs of 3 additional positions for the Licensing and Enforcement program.
