This amendment replaces the bill. It requires the Secretary of State to design a pilot program for early voting for the November 2008 election. The Secretary of State is required to select one volunteer municipality, and may select others, for the pilot program for early voting. The Secretary of State must present its plan for the early voting pilot program to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over legal and veterans affairs by February 15, 2007. The amendment authorizes the committee to submit legislation to authorize the Secretary of State to conduct the early voting pilot program at the November 2008 general election.
