SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 815, L.D. 1186, Bill, "An Act To Clarify the Smoking Ban for Off-track Betting Facilities"

Amend the amendment in paragraph N by striking out all of subparagraphs (5) to (7) (page 2, lines 5 to 27 in amendment) and inserting in their place the following:

(5) The designated smoking area within the purchased or relocated off-track betting facility or purchased or relocated simulcast racing facility has a floor area no larger than 1,000 square feet, except that any designated smoking area larger than 1,000 square feet and in existence on January 1, 2005 is exempt from this subparagraph as long as its size is not expanded after that date;

(6) No slot machines are located within the off-track betting or simulcast racing facility;

(7) The off-track betting or simulcast racing facility is not physically connected to any facility that contains slot machines;

(8) No covered or enclosed direct access to the off-track betting or simulcast racing facility is provided from any facility that contains slot machines;

(9) The designated smoking area is located entirely within a separately enclosed area of an off-track betting facility or simulcast racing facility; and
