## SUMMARY

This amendment changes the maximum size of the smoking area in the newly purchased or relocated off-track betting or simulcast racing facilities from 2,000 to 1,000 square feet. This amendment also specifies that, in addition to restrictions contained in Committee Amendment "A," in order to qualify for exemption from laws prohibiting smoking in public places, the off-track betting or simulcast racing facility may not be physically connected to a facility that contains slot machines, and no covered or enclosed direct access to the off-track betting or simulcast racing facility may be provided from any facility that contains slot machines.
