COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 818, L.D. 1189, Bill, "An Act To Update the Veteran Services Laws and Establish a Commemorative Program for Veterans"

Amend the bill in section 2 in subparagraph (3) by inserting at the end the following new blocked paragraph to read:

'The continuous residency requirement of this subparagraph does not apply to a person who is receiving educational benefits under this chapter on January 1, 2006.'

Further amend the bill by inserting after section 2 the following:

'Sec. 3. 37-B MRSA §509, sub-§2, ¶¶E and F, as enacted by PL 2003, c. 404, §7, are amended to read:

E. An attorney for any person specified in paragraphs A to D of this subsection; e¶

F. A civilian employee or military member of the department when in the conduct of official duties; or

Sec. 4. 37-B MRSA §509, sub-§2, ¶G is enacted to read:

32 This amendment exempts veterans who are receiving

38 appropriations and allocations section.

### Fiscal Detail and Notes

Beginning in fiscal year 2005-06, the Department of Defense, Veterans and Emergency Management will require an annual Other Special Revenue Funds allocation of \$500 to reflect the establishment of a new account to allow the sale of certain commemorative materials. The department will also collect additional Other Special Revenue Funds revenue for the new account; the amounts can not be determined at this time.
