Statutory referendum procedure; submission at statewide 22 election; form of question; effective date. This Act must be submitted to the legal voters of the State at a statewide election held on the Tuesday following the first Monday of November following 24 passage of this Act. The municipal officers of this State shall 26 notify the inhabitants of their respective cities, towns and plantations to meet, in the manner prescribed by law for holding a statewide election, to vote on the acceptance or rejection of 28 this Act by voting on the following question: 30 "Do you favor ratifying the action of the 122nd Legislature whereby it passed an act extending to all citizens 32 regardless of their sexual orientation the same basic 34 protection against discrimination now guaranteed to citizens on the basis of race, color, religion, sex or national of employment, 36 origin in the areas housing, public accommodation, credit and education?" 38 The legal voters of each city, town and plantation shall 40 vote by ballot on this question and designate their choice by a cross or check mark placed within a corresponding square below the word "Yes" or "No." The ballots must be received, sorted, 42 counted and declared in open ward, town and plantation meetings 44 and returns made to the Secretary of State in the same manner as votes for members of the Legislature. The Governor shall review 46 the returns and, if it appears that a majority of the legal votes are cast in favor of the Act, the Governor shall proclaim that
