## **SUMMARY**

4 This amendment provides that the Maine Human Rights Act may not be construed to permit a person to use a locker room or the 6 bathroom facilities of a public rest room designated for use for a gender other than the gender of that person at birth unless the 8 person has undergone a medical procedure to change the person's gender.
