	§4577. Inquiry by employer permitted
24	An employer may ask an employee after that employee is hired
26	to identify that employee's sexual orientation. Information provided by an employee pursuant to this section is confidential
28	and may be used only to ensure that that employee is not discriminated against in the workplace.

32	If an employee's sexual orientation changes, that employee shall notify the employer. An employee who fails to notify an
34	employer of a change in sexual orientation may not file an action pursuant to this chapter claiming discrimination based on sexual orientation.

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HOUSE AMENDMENT "K" to S.P. 413, L.D. 1196

SUMMARY

This amendment provides that an employer may ask an employee 4 after that employee is hired to identify that employee's sexual orientation. Information provided by an employee is confidential 6 and may be used only to ensure that that employee is not discriminated against in the workplace. This amendment also 8 requires an employee to notify an employer if that employee's sexual orientation changes.
