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	Sec.1. 5 MRSA §17804, sub-§5-G is enacted to read:
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	5-G. One-time change of benefit payment option. The

	optional method of payment under subsection 3, 4, 5, 5-A, 5-B,
8	5-C, 5-D or 5-E may exercise at any time a one-time option to
	select a different optional method of payment under one of those
10	sections.
