that fact without delay and the amendment becomes part of the
Constitution of Maine on the date of the proclamation; and be it

Secretary of State shall prepare ballots. Resolved: That the Secretary of State shall prepare and furnish to each city, town and plantation all ballots, returns and copies of this resolution necessary to carry out the purposes of this referendum.

This resolution amends the Constitution of Maine to limit the increase of the taxable value of real property owned by persons who are 65 years of age or older or who are disabled to the rate of cost-of-living adjustments to Social Security benefits. The Legislature is authorized to enact a means test or other income eligibility standards for determining participation.
