Sec. 2. Report. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Economic 8 and Community Development and the Maine Creative Economy Council submit a report that includes their findings and 10 shall recommendations, including suggested legislation, to the Joint Standing Committee on Business, Research and Economic Development 12 no later than December 7, 2005. After receipt and review of the report, the Joint Standing Committee on Business, Research and 14Economic Development may report out a bill to the Second Regular Session of the 122nd Legislature. 16
