pursuant to this resolve must specify when the limitation on the number of renewals of targeted need area certificates for prelingually deaf teachers must be reinstated.'

SUMMARY

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8 This amendment replaces the resolve and requires the State Board of Education to amend the teacher certification rules to 10 provide an alternative means for prelingually deaf teacher certification candidates to demonstrate their proficiency. The 12 amendment also suspends the limitation on targeted need certificates for prelingually deaf teachers to allow prelingually 14 deaf teacher certification candidates more time to demonstrate their proficiency.
